



Universal Care Plan (UCP) Quick Reference Guide: Sickle cell disease

UCP Sections with specific information for patients with sickle cell disease

How to create/update a section :

Find (or import) patient

- Log on to EPR system and find the patient's UCP care plan
- In web portal: search for the patient, if not found, 'add new citizen' demographics will import from NHS PDS data
- You can optionally:
 - Mark as 'my patient' to add to personal list
 - Click "'Add to my organisation list' to add to organisational worklist.

Access (or start) care plan

- If creating a plan for the first time, select '**start plan**' and agree to clinical responsibility and data sharing according to your local guidelines and GDPR regulations for direct care.
- To view an existing patient's UCP, click through the different sections to locate the information required
 - A patient's sickle cell pain plan is stored in the "**Symptom Management plan**" section
 - Information for urgent care professionals can also be found in the **UCP summary**

Update one or more sections

- Update data fields in one or more sections (see sections)
- Sections can be updated and submitted/ activated individually

Submit for other users to view

- You can submit sections based on your role (clinical information requires a clinical user to review)
- Submitting a section makes it 'live' for other users to act on at the point of care
